The Duquesne Club Art and Library Committee is pleased to offer *Deal With It... A Duquesne Club Retrospective on the Work of Tim Menees*, by Dennis Unkovic. This 72-page presentation format book features 66 of Tim's best editorial cartoons, along with a portrait of the artist and commentary.

After growing up in Washington state, serving in the Air Force, and writing for Seattle's morning newspaper, Tim Menees came to Pittsburgh in 1976 as the editorial cartoonist for the *Pittsburgh Post-Gazette*. For almost thirty years, he parodied many Pittsburgh institutions and individuals and rendered humorous commentary on local and national events with his creative drawings. A popular target of his wit was the Duquesne Club, or as Tim calls it, "Ye Olde Steele City Clubbe." Tim's work has appeared in national newspapers, news magazines, and on network television. He has drawn nationally syndicated comic strips, written and illustrated the weekly column "Scorpio," and authored feature stories including accounts of a 24-hour stay inside Pittsburgh's old Western Penitentiary, a week aboard a Great Lakes freighter, and a two-part series on the arts in prison. Among his awards are the National Newspaper Association's top award for weekly cartoons and a Man of the Year nod by Vectors Pittsburgh.

Dennis Unkovic is a partner with Meyer, Unkovic & Scott LLP, where he is responsible for corporate and international matters, including advising foreign companies as well as American companies that conduct global operations. He previously served in Washington, D.C., as the Legislative Director for Hugh D. Scott, former U.S. Senate Minority Leader. He received his Bachelor of Arts with distinction from the University of Virginia and his Juris Doctor from the University of Pittsburgh School of Law, and is affiliated with numerous courts, non-profit, and professional organizations. A prolific writer, he has authored five books and over 135 articles. Dennis was admitted to the Duquesne Club as an Active member in 1979. He was elected a Duquesne Club Director from 2004-2007, and also as Chairman of both the Admissions Committee and the Health and Fitness Center Committee.
